
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Goal: A more skilled, inclusive and productive workforce that enhances Pacific and Timor-Leste prosperity.

- Selected TVET partners demonstrate quality TVETprovision




# Kiribati Graduates

# **Skills for Labour Mobility**

APTC supports labour mobility by delivering targeted training and supporting our partners to develop high quality training programs that provide skills in demand by Australian employers.

This includes:

- Review and implementation of a training profile that supports national and international skills demand and net skills gain;
- Representation at relevant labour mobility regional and sub-regional meetings, such as the annual Pacific Australia Labour Mobility meeting and other conferences and seminars; and
- Ensuring country ownership by engaging and collaborating with key national labour mobility stakeholders, such as government ministries, national training providers, labour sending units, civil society organisations, employer and industry bodies.

The contextualised ready-for-work training targets potential and existing labour mobility recruits identified by the Kiribati Department of Labour from their work-ready pool to ensure employment upon the conclusion of the training.

## Climate Change

We support targeted activities for climate change adaptation and skills for the green economy.

This includes:

- Units on sustainable practices for the environment within APTC training programs.
